

## **Inspection of WUOC 2014 Preparations**

At the weekend, between 31<sup>st</sup> of August and 1<sup>st</sup> of September 2013, there was an inspection of the state of preparations of WUOC 2014 held in Olomouc and its surroundings. Delegates of the International University Sports Federation (FISU) – Mr. Julien Buhajuzek and Mr. Ola Kaberg, accompanied by a supervisor of the International Orienteering Federation (IOF) Mr. Juraj Petrinec, were greatly satisfied and suggested valuable advises to the organizers so that WUOC 2014 could be one of the most successful championships in the history.

Places of particular events and final arenas, course conception as well as the event centre in the university campus of Nefedín were approved. Supervisors also ran through some places where the long distance race will be held. “Selection of terrain for the long distance race is excellent. The terrain is quite easy to run through without any seasonal undergrowth, but on the other hand the race will definitely be a difficult one because of a lot of elevation” FISU Technical Delegate for Orienteering Ola Kaberg said.

The Championships will be held between 11<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> of August 2014 and the organizers expect that about 300 competitors from more than 30 different countries from all around the world will take part in it. Moreover, approximately 600 runners and spectators are expected to take part in public races. More than 150 organizers - volunteers will organize WUOC 2014.
